

Spiritual Intelligence of Secondary School Students

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Abstract:

This research was conducted on 458 students of 9th standards of Kendriya Vidyalaya secondary schools of Gujarat state. The Variables included as Gender, Academic achievement and Literacy of Parents'. In the present research, the survey research method was used. The Kendriya Vidyalaya secondary schools was selected through random sampling method and 9th standards students was selected through cluster sampling method. The result found that there is higher level of Spiritual intelligence in Girl's students than Boys. This result is useful for the Kendriya Vidyalaya school's Principal, teacher, counselor to develop their student's future.

1. Introduction

Spiritual intelligence is the higher dimension of intelligence that activates the qualities and abilities of the authentic soul. In the present study, the standardized Spiritual Intelligence Scale by Pankaj I Parmar is used for this study. There were 75 statements in this scale.

10. Data Analysis method

In the present study Critical ratio had been calculated for checking the Mean, Standard Deviation. Standard Error and Hypothesis.

11. Testing of Hypothesis

Ho₁: There will be no significant between the mean score of Spiritual Intelligence of kendriya vidyalaya secondary school students of Boys and Girls.

As per shown in table No. 1, Mean scores of achieved on the for standard IX by of Spiritual Intelligence Boys student is 306.21, Spiritual Intelligence Girls student is 296.55, Standard deviation is 34.63, and 29.65, Standard error of mean difference is 2.69, and t-Value is 3.36, it can be said that calculated t-value is more than table value 2.58 at 0.01 level.

So, Null hypothesis (Ho₁) There will be no significant between the mean score of Spiritual Intelligence of kendriya vidyalaya secondary school students of Boys and Girls is rejected.

Thus, it can be said that there is significant difference found between Spiritual Intelligence of Boys student and Spiritual Intelligence of Girls student. Girls students were found higher level of Spiritual Intelligence than Spiritual Intelligence Boys students.

So, Null hypothesis (Ho₂) There will be no significant between the mean score of Spiritual Intelligence of kendriya vidyalaya secondary school students of High Academic achievement and Low Academic achievement is accepted.

Thus, it can be said that there is no significant difference found between Spiritual Intelligence of High Academic achievement student and Spiritual Intelligence of Low Academic achievement student.

Ho3: There will be no significant between the mean score of Spiritual Intelligence of kendriya vidyalaya secondary school students of High Literate and Low Literate.

So, Null hypothesis (Ho₃) There will be no significant between the mean score of Spiritual Intelligence of kendriya vidyalaya secondary school students of High Literate and Low Literate Parents is accepted.

Thus, it can be said that there is no significant difference found between Spiritual Intelligence of High Literate Parents' student and Spiritual Intelligence of Low Literate Parents' student.

- 1. The Gender difference does effect on Spiritual Intelligence of Kendriya Vidyalaya secondary school students.
- 2. The Academic achievement does not effect on Spiritual Intelligence of Kendriya Vidyalaya secondary school students.
- 3. The Literacy of Parents' difference does effect on Spiritual Intelligence of Kendriya Vidyalaya secondary school students.
